They are Not pot belly pigs. Kunekune pigs are very loving social-able animals. They have short snouts and don't root. Great for small pieces of land. They do not test fences. They love ear scratches and belly rubs. Make great outdoor pets. Full size is about 300lbs. Much smaller than normal large breed pigs. At full size, they eat 1lb of food twice a day, that equals out to about 1 1/2 bags of food a month per a kunekune. They love pastures, grass hay and alfalfa. Great for orchard clean up as well.
