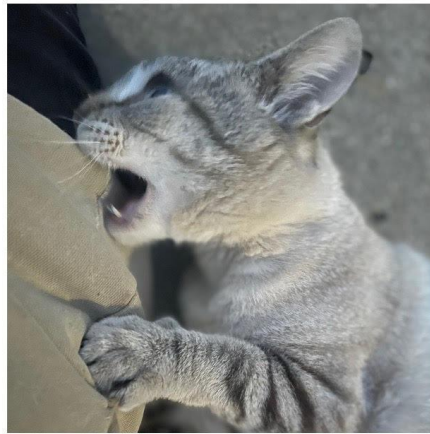


## Courtesy Listing:
